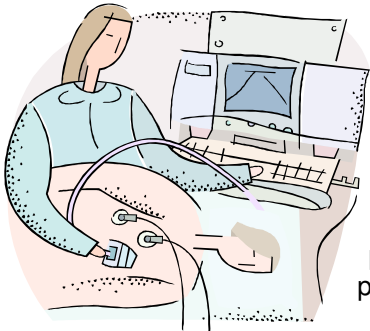


Lean Healthcare Principles Workshop
